

CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY TRAINING COUNCIL OF WASHINGTON – Sheet Metal Worker

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Age: Must be at least 18 years of age (proof of age required).**
- Education: Applicants must have a high school diploma or equivalent at the time of application. Official transcript must show courses and grades.**
- Recommended subjects: Algebra, geometry, metal shop, and wood shop.**
- Physical: Must be physically able to perform the work of the trade.**
- Testing: Sheet Metal applicants must have a qualifying score of 50 or higher on the Scheig Utility worker 1.0 test. The cost of the aptitude test will be paid by the applicant.**
- Other: Applicants shall submit proof of the education, testing, and age qualifications to the Committee before their applications will be considered completed. This must be done within sixty (60) days of date of application. Applicants not completing the application within sixty (60) days will be required to reapply.**
